



Contest Registration

- There shall be no registration fee.
- Each Registrant is required to complete their own Registration Form, with the exception that a minor's form must be completed and signed by their parent/legal guardian.
- The Registration Attendant must verify all Registration Forms with a valid State issued picture I.D., driver's license, tribal I.D., or passport at the time of Check-In/Registration. Social Security numbers will be required for all prize payouts.
- Dancers competing who are 17 years and younger must have a parent or legal guardian present with a valid State issued picture I.D. at the time of registration. Each Dancer/Singer will receive a "Permission to Record and Liability Release" form upon check-in at the event.
- Each Dancer/Singer is responsible for his or her own review of the form, with the exception of minors.
- Each Dancer/Singer age 17 and younger must have a parent or legal guardian present who will be responsible for review of the minor's form and will sign on the minor's behalf.
- All dancers/singers who register for this competition authorize the Forest County Potawatomi Community and Potawatomi Bingo Casino use of his/her photo, name and or image for advertising/promotional and video recording purposes and will complete the "Permission to Record and Liability Release" form at the time of registration.
- Drum/Dancer registration will close at 6:00 pm on Pow Wow Friday and at 1:00 pm on Pow Wow Saturday.

Dancer Check-In/On-Site Registration

- Registration for all Dance categories will be the Friday of Pow Wow weekend from 3:00 pm - 5:50 pm and the Saturday of Pow Wow weekend from 10:00 am – 12:50 pm.
- Dancers are allowed to enter only one category and will not be allowed to switch categories.
- Dancers competing will be issued a number for their category that must be worn visible to those recording numbers.

Drum Group and Singers Check-In/Registration

- The Lead Singer will be identified at the time of registration.
- The Lead Singer for each Drum must be 18 years and older and present a valid State issued picture I.D. at the time of registration.
- The Mentor for each Youth Drum must be 18 years and older and present a valid State issued picture I.D. at the time of registration.
- Youth Drum Singers must show a school or tribal I.D. at Check-In.
- Once Lead Singers are identified they must remain the same all day long for each day. No Lead Passing will be allowed.
