

LET IT RIDE BONUS[®] POKER

HOW TO PLAY

Let It Ride Bonus® Poker appeals to a large audience because of its ease of play—and the chance at a big bonus. The game is played with one deck of cards and up to seven players. The object of the game is to create the best poker hand possible out of your three cards and two community cards. The better the poker hand, the bigger the payout.

GAME PLAY

Players place three equal bets in the circles directly in front of them. The dealer distributes three cards face-down to each player and the same to himself. The dealer then spreads out his three cards face-down and burns (discards) the bottom card. The remaining two are community cards, used by all players—in combination with their own cards—to make the best poker hands possible. The dealer will wave his hand, indicating that players can now look at their cards.

Each player has the option of letting the first bet ride or taking it back. As you can see from the payout table, a pair of 10s or better is needed to be paid on a wager. Based on your three cards—and your own judgment—you can choose to let it ride or take back the wager. You must give a signal to the dealer indicating your decision. Tucking the corners of the cards under the third bet means that you are going to *let it ride*. Lightly scratching the cards on the table signifies you wish to have the first wager pushed out of play. After each player makes a decision, the first community card is turned face-up.

HELPFUL HINTS

ASK FOR \$1 CHEQUES WHEN BUYING IN
SO YOU CAN WAGER THE BONUS.

PLAYERS CAN ONLY USE ONE HAND
TO LOOK AT THEIR CARDS.

PLAYERS CAN ONLY SPEAK ENGLISH AT THE TABLE.

PLAYERS CANNOT SHOW THEIR CARDS TO EACH OTHER.

THE BONUS WAGER CANNOT BE REMOVED.

Each player is then given the option of letting the second bet ride or taking it back. This decision is made regardless of the first bet. Again, the player must tuck the cards under the third bet or scratch the cards on the table. The second community card is then turned face-up.

Regardless of the decisions made concerning the first or second bets, a player may not take back the third bet. After both community cards are turned up, the dealer turns each player's cards face-up. All wagers on hands ranking lower than a pair of 10s are considered losing wagers and are removed.

PAYOUTS

Each winning hand pays as follows:

- Royal Flush 1,000 to 1
(Ten, Jack, Queen, King, Ace of the same suit)
- Straight Flush 200 to 1
(Five cards of the same suit, in sequence)
- Four of a Kind 50 to 1
(Four cards of the same number or face value)
- Full House (Three of a kind and one pair) 11 to 1
- Flush (Five cards of the same suit) 8 to 1
- Straight (Five cards in sequence of any suit) 5 to 1
- Three of a Kind 3 to 1
(Three cards of the same number or face value)
- Two Pair 2 to 1
(Two sets of two cards each, of the same number or face value)
- Pair (of 10s) or Better 1 to 1



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THE BONUS

The bonus wager gives the player a chance to win up to an additional \$25,000. All players have the option to play the bonus by wagering \$1 in the bonus circle before the hand begins. The bonus payout for each winning hand is as follows

- Royal Flush \$25,000
- Straight Flush \$2,500
- Four of a Kind \$400
- Full House \$200
- Flush \$50
- Straight \$25
- Three of a Kind \$5
