Official Rules

1. Eligibility.

The Poker Room's "Bounty Board Bonanza" is open to those 21 years of age or older at the time of entry and must not be listed in the Potawatomi Hotel & Casino Banned Patron List. Employees of Potawatomi Hotel & Casino ("PH&C") and the immediate family members of the Marketing Department, Player Development Department and Upper Management Team which includes Directors, Assistant Directors, Chief Financial Officer, Assistant General Manager and General Manager are not eligible to participate in the Promotion. An immediate family member is defined as a parent, sibling, child, or any other person residing in the same household as employee.

2. Agreement to Official Rules.

By participating in the Promotion, entrant fully and unconditionally agrees to and accepts these Official Rules and the decisions of PH&C, which are final and binding in all matters related to the promotion.

3. Promotion / Qualification Period.

The qualification period for **The Poker Room's "Bounty Board Bonanza"** begins at 4pm Central Time (CT), and ends at 4:00am CT Mondays – Thursdays from February 11 – March 28, 2019. PH&C's computer is the official time-keeping device for this Promotion.

9. Release, Publicity, Use of Personal Information.

10. General Conditions.

PH&C reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify any individual it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Promotion or to be acting in violation of these Official Rules or any other promotion, or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to undermine the legitimate operation of the Promotion may be a violation of criminal and civil law, and should an attempt be made, PH&C reserves the right to seek damages from any such person to the fullest extent of the law. PH&C’s failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.
