

POK19007 Bad Beat Jackpot Official Rules

4/15/19

Bad Beat Jackpot qualifications must be met as follows:

- A promotional dollar is extracted from each qualifying Texas Hold 'Em Table if/when the pot reaches a minimum amount of \$15.
- Texas Hold 'Em games that extract a promotional dollar are exclusively eligible for all promotions using promotional funds.
- "Bad Beat" means: Qualifying high-ranking poker hand that is beaten by a higher-ranking hand.
- A minimum of four players must be dealt in at the start of the hand to qualify.
- For the jackpot to take effect, the two hole cards must play from both the winning and the losing hand. Quads must be made with a pocket pair.
- Hole cards must beat the board. If there is a tie, the board plays.
- In the event that there is more than one qualifying Bad Beat hand, only the second-best hand (the top-qualifying Bad Beat hand) will be paid.
- The hand must go to showdown in order to qualify for the Bad Beat Jackpot, and eligible hands must be turned face-up on the table.
- Winners must have a valid photo ID to claim prize, and are responsible for all applicable taxes.

Bad Beat Jackpot qualifying hands and calculation:

- The Bad Beat will start out at \$10,000 once it has been awarded. The starting qualifying Bad Beat hand is four 10s beat.
- The Bad Beat starts out at four 10s and will decrease one hand ranking as shown below:
 - Four 10s \$10,000–\$20,000
 - Four 9s \$20,000–\$30,000
 - Four 8s \$30,000–\$40,000
 - Four 7s \$40,000–\$50,000
 - Four 6s \$50,000–\$60,000
 - Four 5s \$60,000–\$70,000
 - Four 4s \$70,000–\$80,000
 - Four 3s \$80,000–\$90,000
 - Four 2s \$90,000–\$100,000
 - Aces Full of Kings \$100,000–\$110,000
 - Aces Full of Queens \$110,000–\$120,000
 - Aces Full of Jacks \$120,001–and up until Jackpot is awarded
- The qualifying hand will not go lower than Aces Full of Jacks and will remain at Aces Full of Jacks until the Bad Beat Jackpot has been awarded.
- In the event that the Bad Beat reaches a minimum hand of a full house the secondary player must have quads or better for the jackpot to be hit.

Payouts for the Bad Beat Jackpot are approximately as follows:

- 40% of the Bad Beat will be awarded to the Bad Beat Hand (losing Texas Hold 'Em hand).
- 30% of the Bad Beat will be awarded to the winner of the Texas Hold 'Em hand.
- 30% of the Bad Beat will be awarded equally amongst the other players at the table who were dealt in at the beginning of the hand (and present during the deal).
- The current Bad Beat Jackpot amount is updated and displayed daily in the Poker Room.
- Players will be paid the posted Bad Beat Jackpot.

Bad Beat Jackpot may be void in the event of the following:

- Discussion of the hand while in play or any comments regarding potential Bad Beat hands are prohibited and will result in the disqualification of the hand being a Bad Beat Jackpot hand.
- Cards leaving the clear view of the table at any time.
- Cards dealt out of sequence.
- Too many or too few burn cards.

- Foul deck: too many or too few cards.

All funds collected are allocated into 2 tiers:

- 75% to Promotional Event Fund
- 25% to Bad Beat Jackpot

All funds collected/allocated are awarded via the Bad Beat Jackpot and/or Bad Beat promotional events.

Any patron that has a current ban in place and is deemed ineligible, will forfeit their jackpot payout, and their portion will be donated to a charity of Potawatomi Hotel & Casino's choosing.
