






EVENT CENTER




LEGACY BALLROOM

Whether you're hosting a large conference, an intimate get-together or a reception, the Legacy Ballroom will meet your every need.





GREEN INITIATIVE

In today's day and age, everyone is trying to reduce, reuse and recycle. At Potawatomi Hotel & Casino, we are happy to do our part in preserving our planet for future generations.



The Forest County Potawatomi uses 105% green power, which generates 55 million kilowatt hours annually from renewables.



Each year, hundreds of tons of cardboard, paper, glass and plastic are sent into our singlestream recycling programsaving nearly one thousand cubic yards of

landfill space.



New energy-efficient lighting was installed in our 30-acre parking structure in 2010, saving enough energy to provide annual electricity to 340 homes.



Energy-efficient air hand dryers are installed in all guest and team member bathrooms, reducing the amount of paper towels wasted.



All of the used cooking oil from our restaurants is kept out of landfills and is renewed into usable items such as lubricants and animal feed.



At least 90% of all cleaning products at Potawatomi are green, including cleaning chemicals, EPA-certified and Green Seal equipment, concentrated products and recycled paper products.



The ground surrounding our facility uses sustainable landscaping practices to add beauty and provide benefits to the environment.



The hotel is located in a walkable community that offers community services within a half-mile.

A 20% reduction in water use is achieved through low-flow bathroom and kitchen facilities.



Energy savings are being earned through highefficiency HVAC and lighting systems.



Pollutants and cross-contamination of occupied areas is controlled with walk-off entry mats, high-efficiency filters and well-ventilated rooms.



All adhesives, sealants, paints, coatings, hard floor materials and carpets used in the hotel have lowemitting finishes.



90% of all regularly occupied areas of the hotel have direct line of sight to the outdoors.
