





## HEART OF CANAL STREET FACTS

- When the program began in 1994, benefiting charities each received \$5,000. Last year, 30 charities each received over \$35,000 in funding!
- In 2015, Potawatomi Hotel & Casino added a Charity of Choice—a partner that receives the first \$100,000 in Heart of Canal Street funding to impact change on a pressing community issue. 30 additional charities divide the remaining funds equally.
- In total, the program has contributed nearly \$17 million to hundreds of local children's charities.
- Most Heart of Canal Street funds
  are generated through a special bingo game
  available for purchase during every bingo
  session from August until mid-December.
