



## **GAMING FACT SHEET**

With more than 150,000 square feet of gaming space, there are plenty of options for guests looking for great gaming entertainment. The casino features thousands of slot machines, in a variety of themes and denominations; nearly 100 table games, from blackjack and craps to baccarat and roulette; a huge bingo hall providing high-stakes jackpots during multiple sessions daily; a comfortable 20-table poker where guests can play a number of variations on the popular game; and an off-track betting room featuring the best in horse, greyhound and carriage racing from around the globe.

### **Slots**

Potawatomi Hotel & Casino is full of the latest slot machines featuring state-of-the art technology. Nearly 3,000 machines from the country's leading manufacturers provide guests with plenty of fun and exciting options. Themes from iconic TV shows and movies, like "Back to the Future," "Wheel of Fortune" and "True Blood" keep guests entertained with dazzling visuals and edge-of-your-seat bonus rounds. There are machines for everyone's tastes with video- and reel-style machines featuring denominations ranging from \$.01 all the way to \$100. A large smoke-free slots area is located next to the casino's Bingo Hall on the third floor.

### **Table Games**

With nearly 100 tables on the casino's gaming floor, the selection of options available to our guests is huge – from favorites like blackjack, craps, roulette and baccarat, to carnival-style games like Let it Ride® Bonus Poker and Casino War®. The fast-paced action of the casino's 24-hour, non-smoking poker room features Texas Hold 'Em, Seven Card Stud and Omaha. Guests can call up to two hours in advance to reserve a seat at the table. A rolling bad beat jackpot is a popular promotion; tournaments scheduled regularly.

### **Bingo**

Potawatomi Bingo Casino's Bingo Hall is home to some of the nation's largest daily payouts. Attracting players from across the country, daily payouts average \$75,000. The 1,350-seat Bingo Hall features a 500-seat, non-smoking area, and is complete with large television monitors. Guests can play the games on paper, or the newest in electronic bingo. Glow Party Bingo sessions are held the last Saturday of the month and feature state-of-the-art lights and sound.

### **Off-Track Betting**

The OTB Room, located on the third floor right off the casino's skywalk, is the next best thing to being at the track. The excitement of horse and greyhound racing can be felt in every corner of the 5,000 square-foot, smoke-free space featuring 115 televisions, 80 carrels and seating for nearly 200. Make sure you're here for the Kentucky Derby and the rest of the Triple Crown races. A highlight on the casino's calendar, the races are shown in both the OTB Room as well as on a 20-foot screen in the casino's Northern Light's Theater, where a true party atmosphere prevails.
